**Section 10: Q-RIDE Course Information**

**Purpose of the Course**

The aim of the course is to provide participants with the skills and knowledge to meet Q-RIDE Competency Standards that will enable them to operate motorbikes safely. After completing the certificate, participants will need to present the Q-RIDE certificate to a QLD Transport Customer Service Centre to obtain the appropriate licence.

**Course Delivery**

This course involves theory and practical elements. During the first lesson, the prior knowledge and experience of the trainee will be discussed and assessed. The amount of time required to become competent in all areas will vary from trainee to trainee. RPL or RCC need to be discussed and assessed during the Pre-training Assessment Ride.

**Pre-requisites**

RE motorbike training - Trainees must hold a current RE learner licence.

R motorbike training – Trainees must

- Hold a RE licence and certify that they have held licence for at least 12 months.

Learner licences or receipts must be carried during training. If necessary, the applicant will need to provide a certified copy of their driving history. This is available from Queensland Transport.

All trainees must complete an Application for Q-RIDE training and a Q-RIDE Participation Declaration (Queensland Transport) before training can commence.

**Completion of Course**

When all elements of competency have been achieved, trainees will be issued with a Q-RIDE Certificate. This is not a rider licence. It needs to be presented to Queensland Transport so the appropriate licence can be issued. Participating in a course is no guarantee of being found competent in all areas; further training may be required in some areas.

**Access and Equity**

*Aegis Training Services Pty Ltd* will make all possible efforts to accommodate trainees who have the necessary pre-requisites for training. Trainees will be accepted for training if they can provide verifiable evidence that they meet the Queensland Transport's requirements for a trainee rider and provide prior payment for the training course required. Where a trainee may need further time to learn the skills, Aegis Riding School provides the opportunity to purchase further training in hourly increments at a cost of \$50 per hour.

**Grievance Procedures**

Grievance or Appeal procedures are designed to resolve differences, and bring about benefits with due regard for the interest of the trainee and Aegis Training Services Pty Ltd. The procedures are based upon conciliation and mediation rather than arbitration.

Complaint, Grievance or Appeals concerning course delivery, practice, assessment or any other matter should be directed to the directors Aegis Training Services Pty Ltd. Any complaint is to be investigated by a Director of Aegis Training Services Pty Ltd or another qualified Trainer that was not involved in the training of the student if the Director was the trainer, this Director/Trainer is to act as a third party and must remain impartial when acting on behalf of the student. All grievances must be investigated for validity and a written response returned to the student/client within 14 days of receipt of the initial complaint. If any of the components of the complaint are found to be valid the director is to ensure action is in place to ensure there is no reoccurrence. If a complaint is found to be valid the director is to take all reasonable steps to ensure the student/client is not disadvantaged in any way. This could take the form of Refund, Reevaluation of results etc.

**Refund Policy**

The first \$50.00 of any fee is non-refundable. Trainees can receive a refund of their fee (less the \$50.00 non-refundable portion) if they give written notification of withdrawal from the course/assessment 5 working days before commencement of the course/assessment. Trainees unable to attend may defer until a later course. Refunds will not be granted for unsuccessful completion of the course or assessment.

**Participant Conduct**

Trainees are expected to bring the appropriate licence or receipt to be allowed to ride on the road. They need to wear appropriate protective clothing – long trousers, long sleeve shirt, enclosed footwear and gloves. A helmet complying with AS 1698 Standards (if not supplied by trainer). They are expected to cooperate with the trainer to build a quality-learning environment.
